The Lucas County Health Department will conduct H1N1 vaccination clinics for all Sylvania students on the following dates:

- **Sunday, December 6, 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. at Southview High School**
- **Saturday, December 12, 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. at Northview High School**

During the last two hours of the clinics, community members considered to be in one of the H1N1 high-risk groups will also be invited by Health Department officials to be inoculated.

Attached is a letter from the Health Commissioner Dr. David Grossman and a parent consent form. Parents are encouraged to complete the consent form prior to arriving at the clinic. There will be volunteers at the Southview and Northview sites directing families to the appropriate vaccination stations located in the gymnasiums.
